MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

EDU - INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION (EDU)



AND

BUDAPEST CENTRE FOR THE INTERNATIONAL PREVENTION OF GENOCIDE AND MASS ATROCITIES



RECOGNIZING the need for states to develop or strengthen national mechanisms for the prevention of genocide and other mass atrocities;

RECOGNIZING the importance of greater encouragement of states to cooperate for the prevention of genocide and other mass atrocities through regional and international efforts;

RECOGNIZING that genocide and other mass atrocities remain a threat to world peace and security and that effective genocide prevention requires a multi-dimensional approach to education;

RECOGNIZING that the BUDAPEST CENTRE is an experienced body seeking to promote increased cooperation for genocide prevention;

RECOGNIZING that EDU is an intergovernmental organization keen to promote world peace and stability via greater access to education;

EDU and BUDAPEST CENTRE have agreed as follows:

I.

to establish effective consultation, co-operation, and the exchange of information between them;

II.

EDU and BUDAPEST CENTRE will seek to promote joint activities and projects in accordance with genocide prevention initiatives;

III.

to promote co-operation among top officials from Governments, the academic sector, the business community, national committees and experts;

IV.

to hold periodic meetings to facilitate the exchange of views; to review the provisions and operation of this Memorandum in the light of experience; and to consider modifications and developments to cover specific projects, as appropriate.
